POLICE INVESTIGATING COMMERCIAL BREAKING & ENTERING

SUFFOLK, Virginia (March 28, 2017) Suffolk Police are investigating a commercial breaking and entering that occurred early this morning at the Verizon Wireless store in the 5800 block of Harbour View Boulevard in northern Suffolk.

Emergency Communications was made aware of the incident at 3:44 a.m.

Upon preliminary investigation it was found that three black male subjects broke a front window and entered the business at 3:43 a.m., leaving approximately 1 minute later after taking several electronics items.

The subjects are further described as ranging in height from 5'8" to 6' tall, with one subject wearing gray sweatpants, a black hoodie and white shoes; the second subject wearing black pants, a white shirt and a black knit cap, and the third subject wearing a red bandanna over his face, all black clothing and a black knit cap.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in

court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the TipSubmit mobile app. Tips can be submitted by visiting www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips, or by texting the word “**CRIMES**” (274637) with the keyword **SPDVATIP**. TipSoft also supports users’ ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
