



All City of Suffolk 2nd Half Real Estate Tax bills due Wednesday, June 5, 2019 have been mailed. If you own real estate in the City of Suffolk and did not receive a bill, please contact this office to determine if you owe any tax. State law requires that real estate taxes not paid by June 5 incur a 10% penalty and 10% annual interest. Failure to receive a bill does not relieve penalty and interest.

YOU CAN PAY YOUR BILL ONLINE USING VISA, MASTERCARD, AMERICAN EXPRESS, DISCOVER, E-CHECK, PAYPAL, OR PAYPAL CREDIT. A convenience fee will be added to any payment method via credit or debit card, e-check, PayPal, or PayPal credit. To pay online, go to www.suffolkvatax.us. YOU WILL NEED YOUR CURRENT TAX BILL AND ACCOUNT NUMBER IN ORDER TO PAY ONLINE. You may also pay via telephone by calling 1-866-791-4845 and follow the instructions using your account number. Our office hours are 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, and a payment drop box is located behind City Hall, 442 W. Washington Street, in the parking lot, and in front of the North Suffolk Office location at 2000 Bennett's Creek Park Road in the library, with 24 hour availability.
