



All City of Suffolk 1st half real estate tax bills and personal property tax bills due on December 5, 2019 have been mailed. If you own real estate and/or personal property and did not receive a bill, please contact the City Treasurer's Office to determine if you owe any tax. State law requires that real estate and personal property taxes not paid by December 5th incur a 10% penalty and 10% annual interest. Payments postmarked

December 5th or earlier will be accepted. Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve penalty and interest.

YOU CAN PAY YOUR BILL ON LINE USING MASTERCARD, VISA, DISCOVER, OR AMERICAN EXPRESS AS WELL AS E-CHECK AND PAYPAL/PAYPAL CREDIT.

Please note that each e-check transaction will include a convenience fee of \$1.50. PayPal Credit requires a minimum transaction amount of \$99. A convenience fee of \$0.30+2.5% will be added to any payment method via credit or debit card. To pay on line go to [www.suffolkvatax.us](http://www.suffolkvatax.us). YOU WILL NEED YOUR CURRENT TAX BILL WITH YOUR ACCOUNT NUMBER. While we do not accept payments directly over the telephone at our office, you may pay by telephone by calling 1-866-791-4845 and follow the instructions. Our office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and a payment drop box is located behind City Hall, 442 W. Washington Street, in the parking lot, and in front of the North Suffolk office location at 2000 Bennetts Creek Park Road in the North Suffolk Library, with 24 Hour availability.
