**DISABLED VETERAN APPLICATION  
 PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION/REDUCED TAX RATE**

(Effective 1/1/2021)

**Exemption:** The Constitution of Virginia [Article X, Section 6(a) (8)] and Virginia Code §58.1-3668 exempt from taxation one motor vehicle owned and used primarily by or for any Veteran of the Armed Forces or Virginia National Guard who meets the following requirements:

- Veteran must have been rated by the U.S. Department of Veterans affairs or its successor agency pursuant to federal law with a 100% service-connected, permanent and total disability, OR veteran is being paid at the 100% rate because of unemployability due to service-connected, total and permanent disability.
- The one motor vehicle includes only a passenger car or pickup truck or panel truck that is registered for personal use. Motorcycles, RV's, leased vehicles and vehicles owned by a trust do not qualify.
- Any such motor vehicle owned by a married person may qualify if either spouse is a Veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces or Virginia National Guard who is 100% service-connected, totally and permanently disabled.

**Reduced Rate:** A reduced personal property tax rate is available to veterans who do not qualify for the exemption because they are not 100% service connected, but who qualify under Code of Virginia §58.1-3506(A)(19) and Suffolk City Code 82-202. The reduced rate will be applied to a single motor vehicle owned and regularly used by the veteran. The reduced rate is \$2.125 per hundred dollars of assessed value of the motor vehicle. To qualify, the veteran must have **one** of the following **service connected** disabilities:

- Has lost, or lost the use of, a leg, arm or hand
- Is blind (as defined by Code of Virginia §46.2-100)
- Is permanently and totally disabled
