

### **“Tractor Crossing” Sign (W11-5, W11-5a)**

Upon written request to the Department of Public Works, Traffic Engineering Division, the City Traffic Engineer shall conduct an engineering study and may, at his discretion, erect a “Tractor Crossing” signs at locations where tractors or other large mechanical equipment frequently cross state roadways. No one owner shall be entitled to the placing of signs at more than one location on a single or abutting tract(s) of land. Typical locations which might be appropriate for such installations are areas with a history of accidents and/or areas with sight distance restrictions where the crossing cannot be relocated to provide adequate visibility. This sign is not intended to be installed within subdivisions or on dead-end or unpaved roads due to slow speeds and local traffic. Consideration of the engineering study may include but is not limited to traffic volumes, approach speeds, street design and condition, sight distance, accident history, and frequency of crossing.

*\* Should the agricultural operation cease, it shall be the owner’s responsibility to notify the City Traffic Engineer that the sign is no longer warranted and may be removed.*
