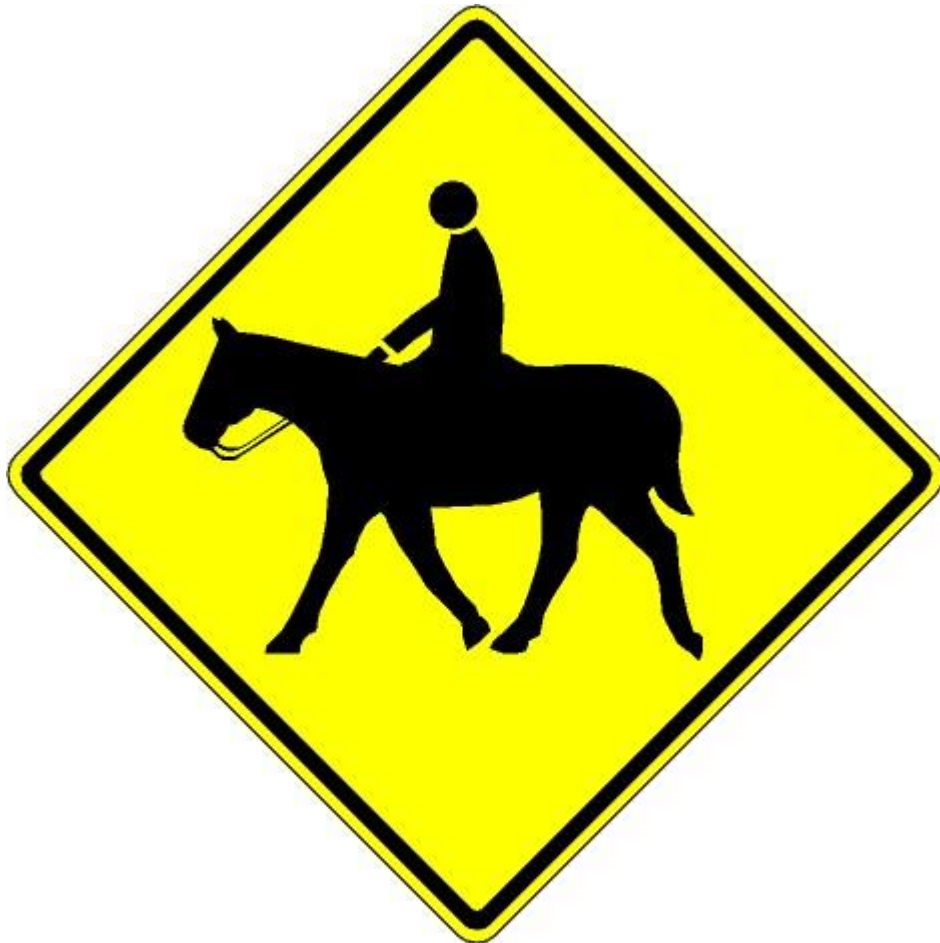


### **“Horse and Rider” Sign (W11-7)**

Upon written request to the Department of Public Works, Traffic Engineering Division, the Traffic Engineering Manager shall conduct an engineering study and may, at his discretion, erect a “Horse and Rider” sign at locations where riders frequently use bridle paths to cross city roadways. Typical locations which might be appropriate for such installations are areas with a history of accidents and areas with sight distance restrictions where the bridle path cannot be relocated to provide adequate visibility. This sign is not intended to be installed within subdivisions or on dead-end or unpaved roads due to slow speeds and local traffic. Consideration of the engineering study may include but is not limited to traffic volumes, approach speeds, street design and condition, sight distance, accident history, and frequency of crossing.
